

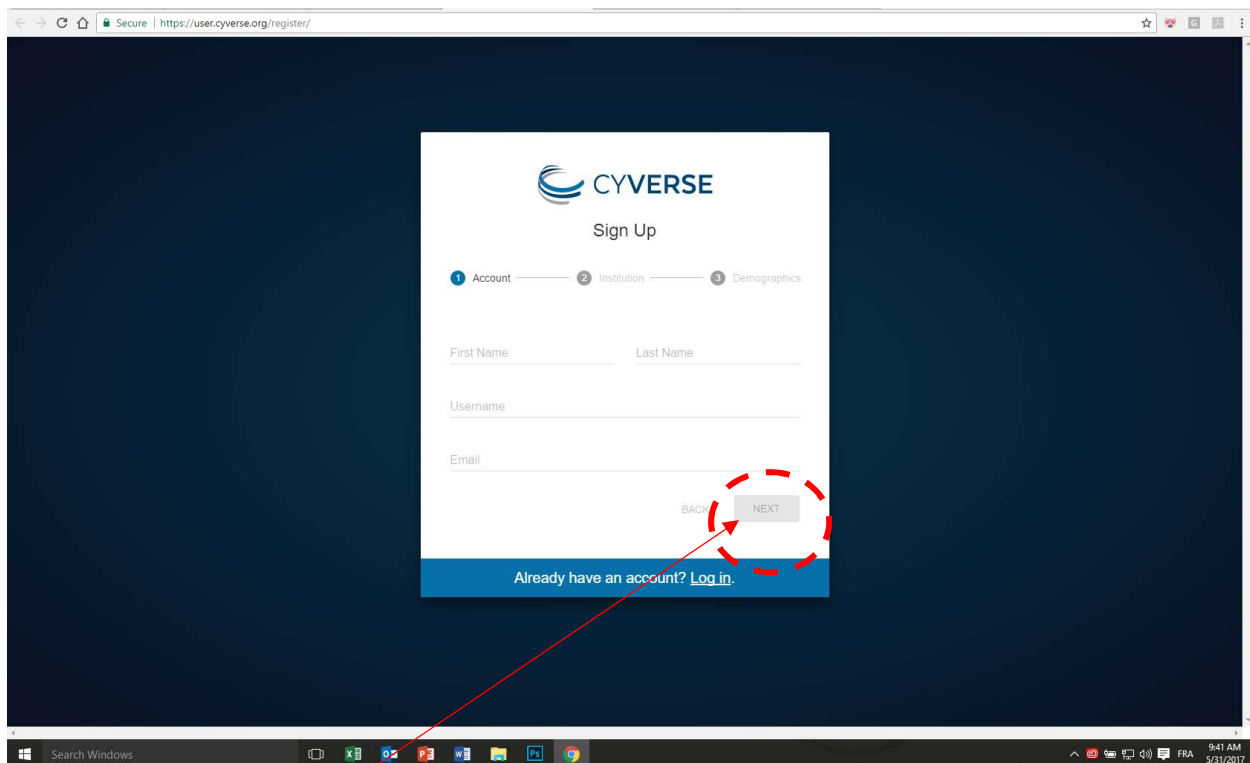
The Integrated Breeding Platform is hosted on [CyVerse](#). To gain access to some of our products and services, you will therefore need to register for an account with their registration management system.

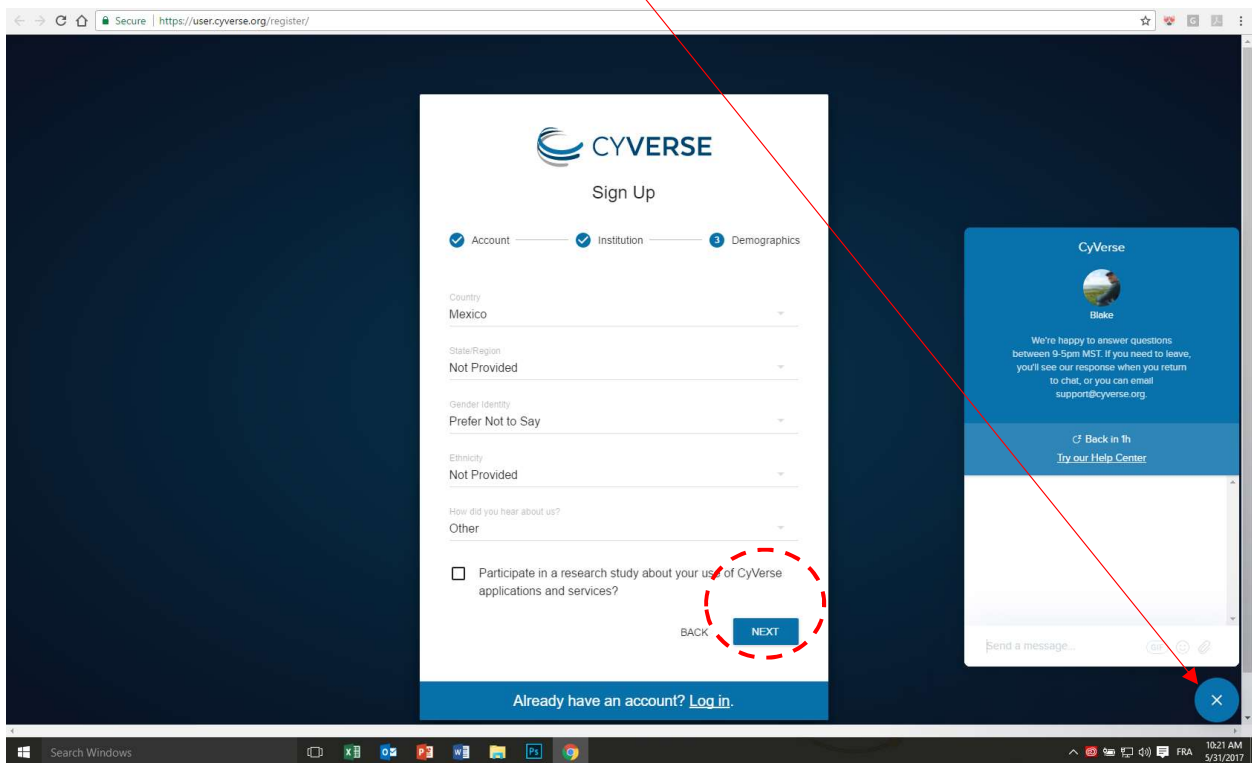

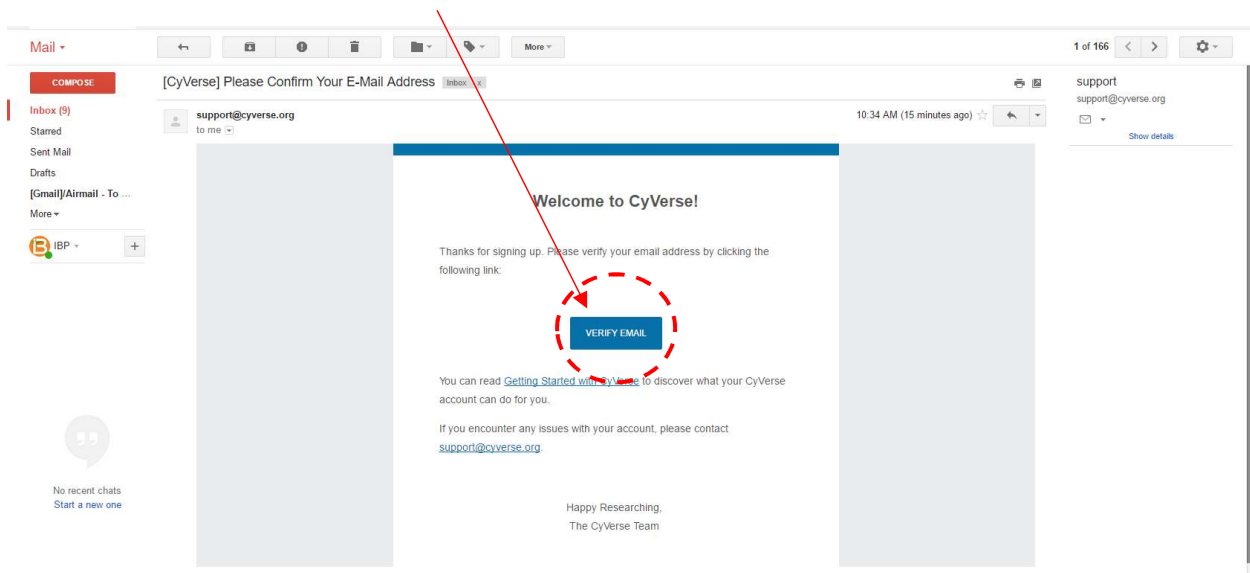


Click next to finish this part of the registration process.

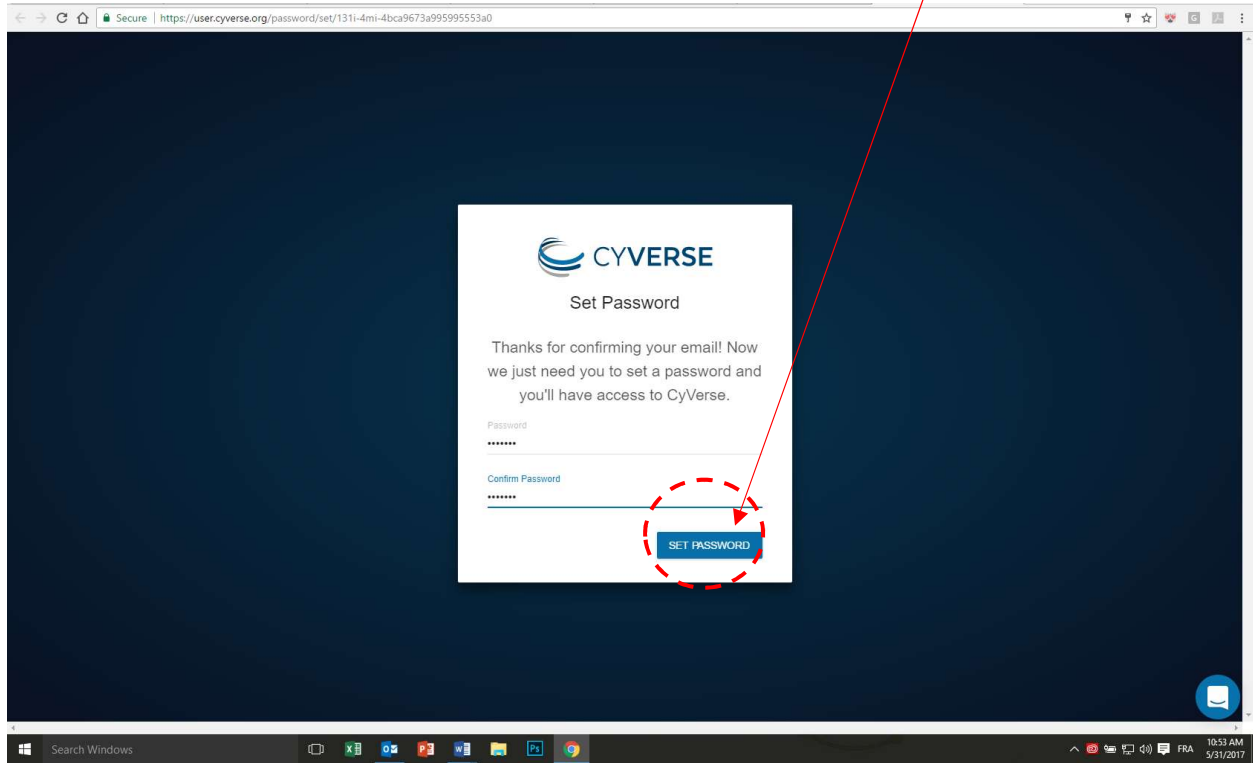

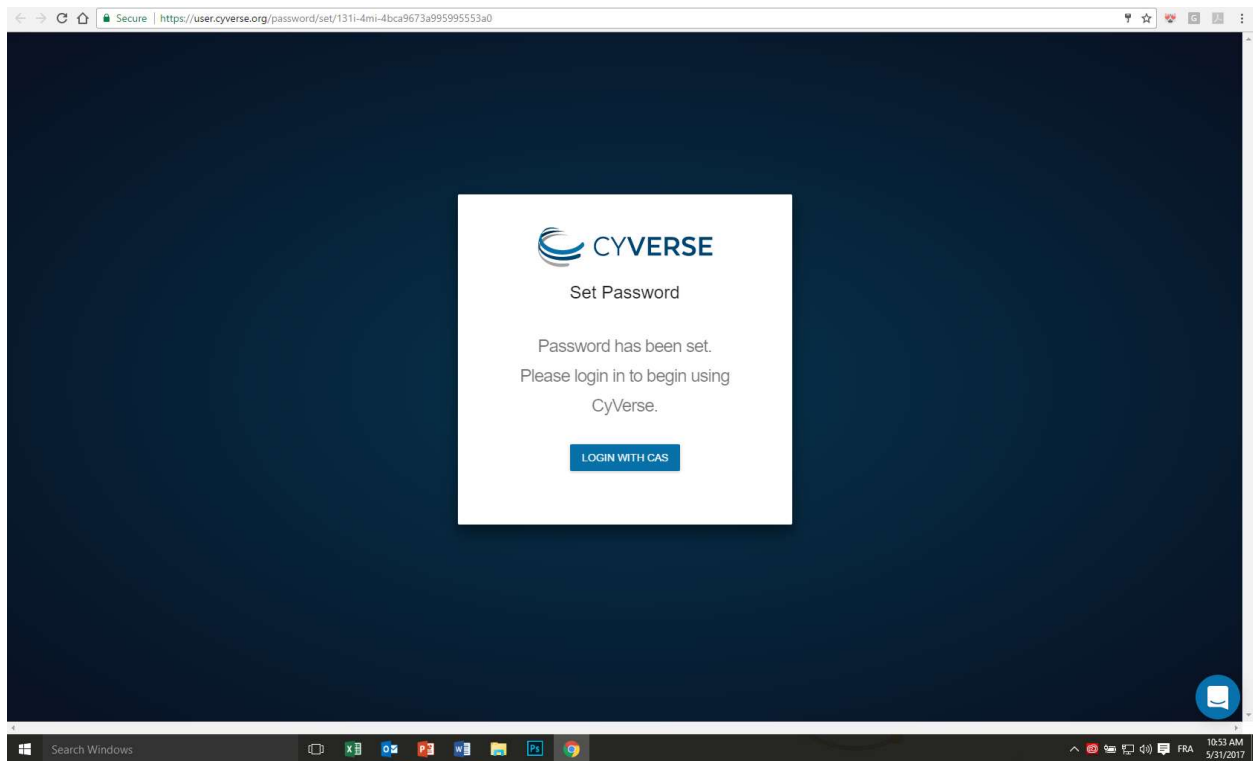
From your inbox, open the message you received from CyVerse. Click on the 'Verify email' button provided in your email to complete the registration process:
